A family member of a citizen of the United Kingdom must attach the following to an application for the issuance or extension of the temporary residence permit:

- a personal photograph or reference number from the clipboard for electronic photographs;
- an identity card or passport or a certified photocopy of an identity card or passport;
- proof of kinship, if the relevant facts are not entered in the civil register in the Republic of Slovenia;
- proof of sufficient means of subsistence, whereas these means must not, on a monthly basis, be below the threshold under which the right to financial social assistance is granted under the act regulating social security;
- proof of adequate health insurance that covers at least emergency medical services in the Republic of Slovenia;
- a certificate from the criminal record of the home country; in an application for an extension only if the authority so requests.

In the procedure, the administrative unit will obtain the following information under compulsory powers:

- from the civil register of the Republic of Slovenia on the birth or marriage of the foreigner in the territory of the Republic of Slovenia, or on other information, if it is entered in the civil register of the Republic of Slovenia;
- on compulsory health insurance in the Republic of Slovenia, when the foreigner states that they have compulsory health insurance in the Republic of Slovenia when providing proof of health insurance:
- from the criminal record, the record of final judgements or decisions on misdemeanours kept by the Ministry of Justice in the Republic of Slovenia;
- from the record on decisions on misdemeanours kept by the competent authorities in the Republic of Slovenia;
- whether criminal or misdemeanour proceedings have been initiated against the foreigner in the Republic of Slovenia by the competent authorities in the Republic of Slovenia.

Information regarding personal data protection:

- the personal data from the form is processed for the purpose of issuance of a residence permit in accordance with Article 93 of the Foreigners Act;
- the authority has the right to obtain other data as well, if this is in your interest and you have given your consent or if this is permitted by law. You can withdraw your consent from the authority at any time;
- if the required conditions are met, you have the right to access your personal data, the right to restrict processing and the right to object to processing;
- you have the right to check the accuracy of your personal data that is entered in the residence permit and the right to request for the data to be altered or, if the required conditions are met, its deletion.
- The controller stores your data in accordance with Article 115 of the Foreigners Act;

- if you are of the opinion that your data is being processed illegally, you can file a complaint with the Information Commissioner.
